1st/2nd Class

Lesson Plan: Puppet Making

Lesson Task:

Pupils will be asked to make a puppet of a fruit/veg character. Using material, cardboard, paper, wool etc

Learning Outcomes:

- Pupils will learn how to visually create an imagined character.
 - Experiment with different ways of creating shape, form, structure and texture.
 - Explore how the use of different materials can create structure, shape a texture.
 - Understand the importance of shape and colour in creating their fruit/veg character.
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3/4th Class

Lesson Plan: Still Life Collage

Lesson Task:

Pupils will be asked to create a collage of a still life. They will use different colour paper to create shape and texture.

Learning Outcomes:

- Explore different ways of creating shape and texture from coloured paper.
 - Understand how to create foreground, middle ground and background.
 - Explore ways of creating tone and form within the collage.
 - Explore ways in which tearing, cutting, folding and scrunching paper can create texture.
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5/6th Class

Lesson Plan 1: Comic Strip

Lesson Task:

The pupils will be asked to create a comic strip using the Food Dudes programme as inspiration. They can either create their own super hero story or develop a new adventure for the Food Dudes themselves.

Learning Outcomes:

- Pupils will develop an understanding of how to create a narrative through images.
- Understand the importance of colour in creating a comic strip.
- Use colour and line to create movement.

Lesson Plan 2: _____ Self Portrait as a super hero

Lesson Tasks:

Pupils will be asked to portray themselves as a super hero character.

Learning outcomes:

- Understand the use of proportion while drawing the human figure.
- Develop their understanding of creating texture and tone.
- Use symbols and images to portray their individual super heroes.
- Use colour to portray characteristics of their super hero.
