Tasting and Trying Challenge

This week on Food Dudes Fun at Home we are learning about the importance of tasting and trying foods in order to learn to like them. The Food Dudes know how important it is to taste a food many times to get to like it. Sometimes it can take more than TEN tries to like something! Sometimes, we eat with our eyes instead of our taste buds, and while it is important that the food's we eat look nice and colourful and healthy, sometimes they might not look perfect, but still taste yummy! This week, we have a special activity for tasting and trying some different foods.

This week's activity is based around your taste buds. The test will allow them to recognise the primary tastes; sweet, salty, bitter and sour.

Taste test:

- Set up a testing station, to help your child focus solely on taste. Clear a table and set it with a white tablecloth.
- Place bite sized portions of each food in ramekins/small plates/muffin tray
- Have your child close their eyes, or cover them using a blindfold and help them to take a seat at the table. Make sure they don't see the foods beforehand!
- Allow your child to try each food, observing the flavours, textures and scents and let them indicate which tastes they recognise.
- Have a discussion afterwards and see if some foods were difficult to distinguish/what they liked most/why they didn't enjoy a food etc.
- Once they have tried each food, ask them to complete the table below at the end of the game.
